This letter describes the program and options.

All classroom sessions are held at Greendale High School during the designated times. All missed classes must be made up. A teen must be at least 15 years old by the first class session in order to be enrolled in the classroom; 15 and ½ to obtain the permit. Student’s can receive their permit prior to class completion if age eligible.

All Behind-the-Wheel lessons will start and end at Greendale High School. After the completion of each drive, the AAA instructor will conduct a feedback session with the student’s parent or guardian. This feedback session will be conducted in-person if the parent or guardian is available after the student’s drive or the instructor will contact the parent the same day. We feel the feedback on the student’s progress is important to the parents who will continue the teaching process with their student after each lesson and when the Driver Training program is complete.

AAA’s Behind-the-Wheel program is based on pre-defined routes for each lesson. This method is to ensure that each student experiences the different driving environments and skills necessary to become a safe and proficient driver. We believe that to ensure a complete education, each student must experience and learn the skills specifically identified by the curriculum for a specific drive. We start all students



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with basic skills such as left and right turns, backing, stopping, and going. With each drive we will add additional skills, environments, judgment situations and risks.

AAA offers two packages, Basic: Classroom and 6 hours of driving with 6 hours of observation or Premium: Classroom and 8 hours of driving with 2 hours of observation. The Premium package allows the instructor and students to concentrate on more advanced skills such as off-road recovery. The cost for each of the package options is as follows: **Basic** \$340 or **Premium** \$420. An additional 1 hour behind the wheel is available for purchase should the teen and parent prefer no observation hours.
