EARLY GRADUATION

Students who will complete their graduation requirements (see below) by the end of the first semester of their senior year may elect to graduate early. Students considering this option must complete the following by **May 1, 2018**.

- A written letter requesting early graduation and reasons for;
- A letter from parent/guardian in support of student's request;
- An early graduation request form available from your counselor;
- Approval from principal and Board of Education;
- Parent/guardian and student must meet with counselor to develop a plan of action; and
- An exit conference is **required** in December.
